INDUSTRY “ACCESS” TO APPROVED E-EXAM VENUES IN AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND

The Civil Aviation Safety Authority of Papua New Guinea wishes to notify Industry that since the launch of our Port Moresby e-exam center on 23rd February 2016, all basic license exams (including PNG AME Air Law exam) for the attainment of PNG Aircraft Maintenance Engineer License prescribed under Civil Aviation Rule Part 66, are now accessible through the online e-exam booking portal for PNG on: <https://casapng.aspeqexams.com>.

The E-exam sessions conducted in Port Moresby to date have been successful and are currently conducted once per month based on current demand.

A real benefit of entering into a partnership agreement with e-exam specialists ASPEQ, New Zealand is to provide PNG Air Operators and individuals access to approved e-exam centers throughout Australia and New Zealand, where PNG candidates may book and sit for PNG Air Law and other basic AMEL exams at these overseas venues.

This notification provides you with information and links to interested parties wishing to access PNG AMEL exams (including PNG AME Air law exam) in approved venues in Australia and New Zealand.

PNG CANDIDATES WISHING TO SIT PNG AIR LAW OR PNG AMEL BASIC EXAMS IN AUSTRALIA OR NEW ZEALAND should contact ASL Operations Support Manager: Ms Debby Walker via email: Debby.Walker@aspeq.com with your preferred location and date(s) for the exam. ASPEQ will then contact us for permission and once this is granted, they will advise you on the process to make this possible.
