



Job Opportunities

The Civil Aviation Safety Authority of Papua New Guinea (CASA) is responsible for establishing aviation safety and security standards, issuing licenses and certificates, controlling entry into the civil aviation system, conducting industry surveillance and undertaking safety promotion and education activities.

To promote the highest level of aviation safety and security in PNG, CASA seeks to recruit qualified, experienced and skilled persons to immediately fill the following positions:

1. Senior Aviation Security Inspector

Reporting to the Manager Aviation Facilities, the Senior Aviation Security Inspector will be responsible for aviation security oversight of the Aviation Security Service providers to ensure that ground facilities and company policies and practices meet the minimum security requirements stated in the PNG civil aviation rules.

The key requirement of this position is holder of ICAO accredited Aviation Security qualification or equivalent and five years work experience as a senior aviation security Inspector.

2. Airport Inspector (Civil Engineer)

Reporting to Manager Aviation Facilities, the Airport Inspector will be responsible for carrying out safety oversight and conducting audits on all aerodromes to ensure that they meet the minimum safety requirements. The primary responsibility of the Airport Inspector is to monitor and ensure airports comply with the requirements of the Civil Aviation Act & Civil Aviation Rules

The key requirement of this position is holder of a Civil Engineer Degree or relevant technical qualifications with five years' work experience as an Aerodrome Inspector.

3. Airworthiness Inspector (Engineering)

Reporting to the Manager Airworthiness, the Airworthiness Inspector will be responsible for carrying out safety oversight and conducting audits on airline operators and ground facilities to ensure that aircrafts and facilities meet the minimum safety standards.

The role will also include validation of aircrafts, issuance certificates/permits in accordance with safety standards as required under the Civil Aviation Rules.

The key requirement of this position must be LAME holder with specialization, experience and training in types of aircrafts.

4. Airworthiness Inspector (Maintenance)

Reporting to the Manager Airworthiness, the Airworthiness Inspectors will be responsible for carrying out safety oversight and conducting audits on airline operators and ground facilities to ensure that aircrafts and facilities meet the minimum safety standards.

The role will also include airworthiness interface between airline operators and manufacturers to ensure continuing airworthiness of aircrafts in accordance with safety standards as required the Civil Aviation Rules.

The key requirement of this position must be LAM holder with specialization, experience and training in types of aircrafts.

5. Defects, AD & Reliability Inspector

Reporting to the Manager Airworthiness, the Airworthiness Inspectors will be responsible for carrying out safety oversight and conducting audits on aircraft defects and technical aspects ensure that aircrafts and facilities meet the minimum safety standards.

The role will also include airworthiness interface between airline operators and manufacturers and the Civil Aviation Safety Authority on compliance and safety standards as required the Civil Aviation Rules.

The key requirement of this position must be LAME holder with specialization, experience and training in types of aircrafts.

6. Licensing Inspector (Flight Crew)

Reporting to the Team Leader (Personnel Licensing), the Flight Crew Licensing Inspector will be responsible for managing the process of validation and approval of flight crew personnel certificates, licenses and documents in accordance with the safety standards as required under the Civil Aviation Rules.

The key requirements of this position are current holder or have held a PNG CPL or ATPL with 10 years flying experience and acquired 5000 flying hours.
