CA RULE PART 108 MATRIX

The following are the 108 Rule Part references that must be addressed in the Security Program that has to be provided with an application for a Part 129 Foreign Air Operators Certificate, if the aircraft intends to carry 10 or more fare paying passengers [129.61]

Against each Rule Part record the paragraph number in the Security Manual that satisfies the Rule.

It is frequently found that foreign airline submit an existing Security Manual that is used for other countries, but not every Papua New Guinea requirement is included. Using the matrix will shorten the taken to issue a Certificate and will also ensure that any additional matters have been addressed:
