The Civil Aviation Safety Authority of Papua New Guinea (CASA) is responsible for establishing aviation safety and security standards, issuing licenses and certificates, controlling entry into the civil aviation system, conducting industry surveillance and undertaking safety promotion and education activities.

To promote the highest level of aviation safety and security in PNG, CASA seeks to recruit qualified, experienced and skilled person to immediately fill the position below:

1. Defects, AD & Reliability Officer

Reporting to the Manager Airworthiness, the Defects, AD & Reliability Officer will be responsible for collecting quantitative and qualitative data from industry to construct safety baselines for each operator and report safety trends in relation to aircraft system defects and engine reliability.

The role will require a good understanding of statistics and a unique ability to analyze various quantitative and qualitative data, interpret key safety performance indicators and compile safety reports for the Manager, Airworthiness. The role also includes the drafting of airworthiness directives (ADs) based on the outcomes of safety analysis, as applicable.

The key requirement of this position is that the prospective candidate must be a holder of an aeronautical engineering degree or other equivalent engineering degree from a recognized university.
