Exemption from the Requirements in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 92.205

PURSUANT TO Section 79(1) of the *Civil Aviation Act 2000* (as amended),

I, WILSON SAGATI, OBE, Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that -

- (a) the Papua New Guinea Government's restrictions in response to the threat of the spread of the corona virus COVID-19, in particular the State of Emergency of the COVID-19 alert system from Tuesday 24 March 2020, are an event that make the prescribed requirements to complete a dangerous good training programme inappropriate in this particular case; and
- (b) the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

HEREBY EXEMPT —

Any person required under Civil Aviation Rule CAR 92.203 to have completed a recurrent dangerous goods training programme within 2 years of completing a dangerous goods training programme

FROM —

the requirement in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 92.205 that each person who is required under 92.203 to have completed a dangerous goods training programme shall

- (1) within 2 years of completing the programme, undertake a recurrent dangerous goods programme; and
- (2) repeat the recurrent dangerous goods training programme at intervals not exceeding 2 years.

ONLY WITH RESPECT TO—

Persons who have completed a dangerous goods training programme from February 2018.

PROVIDED THAT—

The recurrent training is completed before the expiry of this exemption.

This exemption shall remain in effect until **23 September 2020** unless withdrawn earlier in writing by the Director.
