General Exemption from the Requirements in Civil Aviation Rule CAR 91.547 – ADS-B OUT Equipment

PURSUANT TO Section 79(1) of the *Civil Aviation Act 2000* (as amended),

I, WILSON SAGATI, OBE, Acting Director of Civil Aviation, being satisfied that-

- (a) the Papua New Guinea Government's restrictions in response to the spread of the virus COVID-19, in particular the restrictions on international travel, are an event that make the prescribed requirements for the fitment of ADS-B OUT transmitting equipment in accordance with Part 91.547 on or before the specified date for specific designated airspaces is unreasonable in this particular case; and
- (b) the risk to safety will not be significantly increased by the granting of this exemption,

HEREBY EXEMPT—

Any PNG registered aircraft required under CAR 91.547 to be fitted with ADS-B OUT within the specified period under Transition Rule 20;

FROM —

the requirement of Civil Aviation Rule Part 91.547, 91.432 and other rule parts prescribing the requirements for equipage of ADS-B OUT for 12 months.

ONLY WITH RESPECT TO-

Aircraft operating within Class C and F airspaces designated under Part 71 by the Director within the Port Moresby Flight Information Region.

This exemption shall remain in effect until **31 August 2021** unless withdrawn earlier in writing by the Director or effected by Civil Aviation Rule changes.
