



# Job Opportunities

The Civil Aviation Safety Authority's (CASA) primary function is to conduct the safety and security regulation of civil air operations in PNG. CASA performs the following regulatory functions:

- develop, establish and promulgate safety and security standards
- monitor adhere to safety and security standards
- conduct comprehensive aviation industry surveillance
- issue, suspend and revoke aviation documents
- promote safety and security in the civil aviation system by providing safety and security information through education programs

To promote the highest level of aviation safety and security in PNG, CASA seeks to recruit qualified, experienced and skilled persons to immediately fill the positions below:

## 1. Flight Operations Inspector (Rotary Wing)

Reporting to Senior Flying Operations Inspector (Rotary Wing), the Flying Operations Inspector is responsible for conducting audits and surveillance on helicopter operations within PNG to monitor compliance with the requirements of the Civil Aviation Act, the Civil Aviation Rules and the operator's Exposition.

The key requirement of this position is at least have five (5) years' experience in command of multi-engine helicopter. Hold or have held an Air Transport Pilot Licence – Helicopter with Command Instrument rating with extensive operational experience with a minimum of 3,000 hours as pilot in command with sound knowledge of Civil Aviation Act and Civil Aviation Rules.

Application for FOI-Rotary wing is open to both National and Non-Citizen candidates.

## 2. Defects, AD and Reliability Officer

Reporting to the Manager Airworthiness, the Defects, AD & Reliability Officer will be responsible for collecting quantitative and qualitative data from industry to construct safety baselines for each operator and report safety trends in relation to aircraft system defects and engine reliability.

The role will require a good understanding of statistics and a unique ability to analyze various quantitative and qualitative data, interpret key safety performance indicators and compile safety reports for the Manager, Airworthiness. The role also includes the drafting of airworthiness directives (ADs) based on the outcomes of safety analysis, as applicable.

The key requirement of this position is that the prospective candidate must be a holder of Mechanical or an Aeronautical engineering degree or other equivalent engineering degree from a recognized university.
